Subject: Information and Rules & Regulation regarding South Zone Inter University Chess (Men) Tournament from 4th to 7th December, 2018.

Dear Sir/ Madam,

We extend a warm and hearty welcome to you and your team to the South Zone Inter University Chess (men) Tournament 2018-19 being organized by Manipal Academy of Higher Education from 4th to 7th December 2018.

Please note down the important information regarding the tournament as mentioned below:-

Team Manager's Meeting of the participating Universities for South Zone Inter University Chess - Men Tournament 2018-19 will be held on 3rd December 2018 at Dr.TMA Pai Hall, 3rd Floor at 5.00 pm.

1. Inaugural & Closing Ceremony will be conducted as follows:

- 2. No team will be allowed to participate in the Tournament without its Team Manager.
- 3. The Team Manager should bring 4 copies of Eligibility Proforma duly typed and signed by Competent Authorities and submit the same at the arrival. The players should bring individual Photo identity card attested by the competent authorities of their respective university. Also 10th & 12th Mark sheet with age proof, Diploma / Degree provisional Certificate of the players duly signed and attested by the Director of Physical Education.
- 4. All the participating Universities are requested to submit AIU Annual Subscription Fee copy for Academic Session 2018-19.
- 5. Teams are requested to participate in a Proper Dress Code with ID card for the Inaugural Function.
- 6. As per the guidelines of AIU, officiating charge Rs.2, 500/- will be collected at the time of registration.
- 7. Teams are requested to report at the venue 30 minutes before the start of the match in proper sports kit and respective ID-card.
- 8. Team managers will be responsible for maintaining the discipline at the venue of the Tournament and also at the place of their stay.
- 9. In case of any protest, a fee of Rs.2, 000/- will be charged. The protest will be entertained within 2 hours of the supposition of the match.
- 10. Every Team should bring two (2) sets of chess Board and chess clocks in working order without which they are not permitted to participate in the tournament.
- 11. The teams will be provided with a semi furnished accommodation in our University Campus. Accommodation will be provided only a day prior to the commencement of the match.

- 12. All the participating teams are requested to inform their arrival date & time and the mode of transport to the organizing Secretary well in advance (9880114930).
- 13. A Team consists of a maximum of six players.
- 14. A Caution deposit of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) will be collected at the Reception Counter. The Amount will be refunded at the time of Check – out with deduction if any, in respect of damages etc.
- 15. The food will be arranged in the MAHE University Food court on Payment on prior request.
- The teams which fail to Report on time will be scratched by the Officials and Tournament Committee.
- 17. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to change, to advance, to postpone, or to alter the tournament schedule, if necessary. However, prior intimation will be given to the Managers while making such changes.
- Tournament will be organized strictly in accordance with latest Rules and Regulations adopted by All India Chess 18. Federation and the guidelines of the AIU will be applied for the competition.
- 19. Strict discipline needs to be maintained in the University Campus.
- Smoking, consuming alcohol/drugs are strictly prohibited in hostel and campus.
- 21. Participants are advised to keep the valuable items under their safe custody (If any lost, management and organizing authorities are not responsible for it).
- 22. In case of any indiscipline or misconduct by players/team/coach/manager, the organizing committee reserves the right to take disciplinary action.
- 23. All Participants and Team Managers and coaches are requested to wear the Identity card inside the campus.
- 24. The organizing Committee reserves the right to make any changes in the programme of the Tournament. The decision made by the organizing committee shall be final in all matters concerning the tournament.
