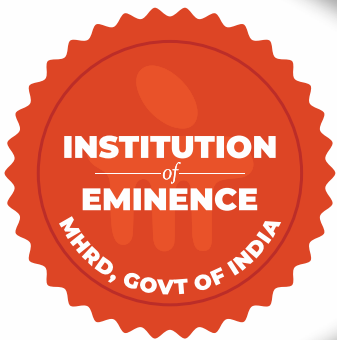

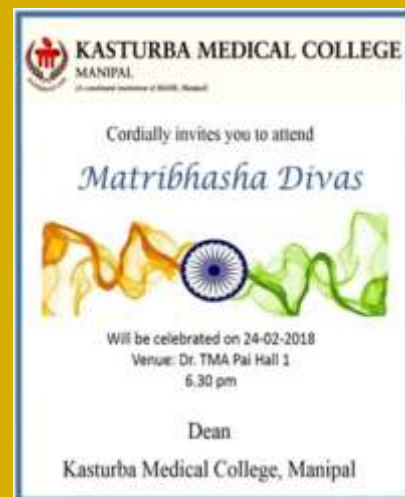

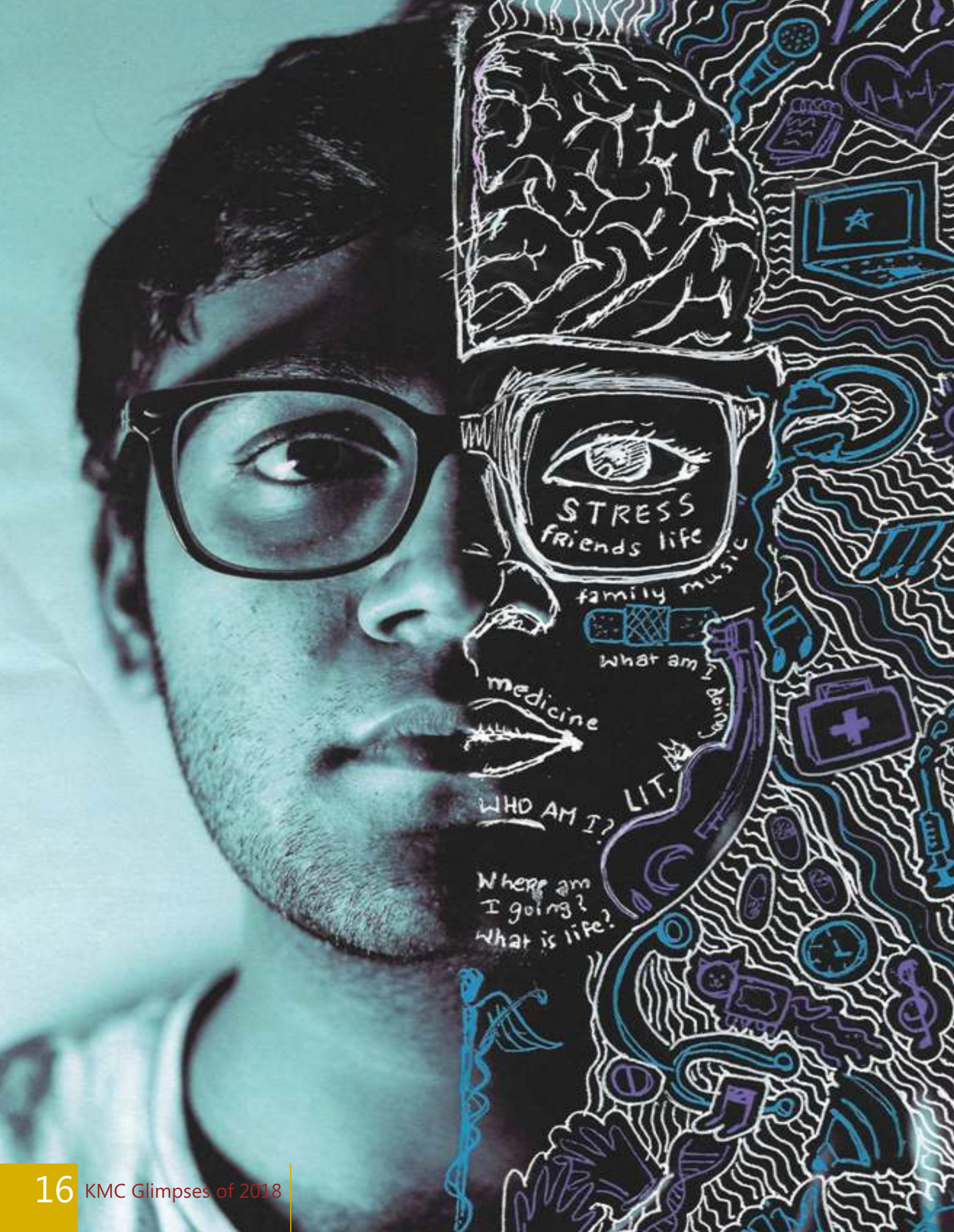

-A New interim Student Council has been elected, being led by Sneha Makkapati.

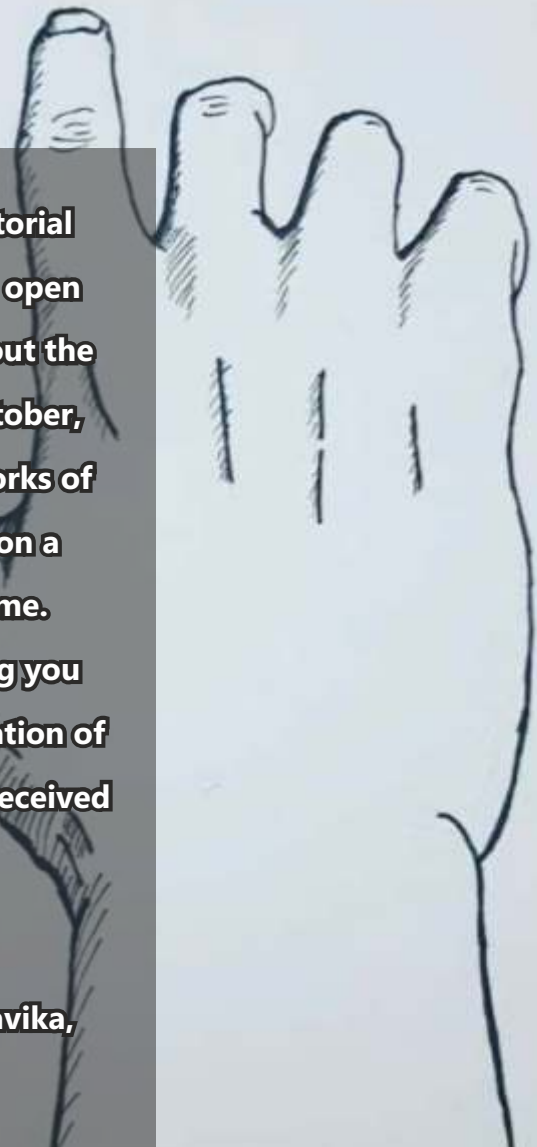
-Exams are around the corner for most of the college as late nights and coffee breaks become more frequent.
