- 5. Subject of the mail should be National pharmacovigilance Week- Name of the participating event.
- 6. Ensure that all content in your animation/video or E- poster or Essay is your own, and it should not be copied from any other video/ animation or poster or essay. If found, participant entry can be disqualified.
- 7. The video/ animation or E- poster or essay will be judged according to the content, creativity and presentation.
- 8. Best 3 participants from each of the above mentioned category of event will be given e-certificates and their names will be displayed in the PvPI quarterly Newsletter.
