



### Orthodontists develop novel tool to manage cleft lips

r Ashith MV supported by post graduate student Dr Nukala Sree Suma from the Manipal College of Dental Sciences Mangaluru have developed a 3D Versascrew – a novel approach for management of bilateral cleft lip and palate. This corrects the alignment of the premaxilla and makes it easy for surgical repair. The

innovation recently won the first prize (Clinical section) at the Innovation competition organized by Manipal University at Manipal.

Manipal University at Manipal. Speaking to Bangalore Mirrot, Dr Ashith, Reader, Department of Orthodontics said this is a clinical innovation for treating newborn cleft lip babies. Regarding cleft lip, in India there are lots of issues that includes cost factor, time- as lot of people who come to Mangaluru for treatment from far off places and they find it difficiult for regular frequent visits. With 3D Versascrew, we train the care taker to treat the patient and this screw will help in reducing the frequency of visiting the doctor now.

A cleft lip can range from a little notch in the coloured part of the lip to a complete separation of the upper

lip which can extend up and into the nose. This can affect one side of the mouth (unilateral) or both sides (bita-ceral), and can be complete or incomplete. Dr Ashith developed the innovation about three years ago and has treated about five cases using this method and the first case treated is about three years now.

He said, cases presenting with the defect on both the sides have problems with feeding, speech, the upper law segment projecting out, collapsed nose, increased gap between lip segments which complicates suturing and also psychological problems associated with the unpleasing appearance. The teeth bearing portion of upper arch is not continuous and presents as three discrete fragments together. The earlier the treatment is initiated, the better is the outcome as the infant's physiology can be utilised to correct the severity of the deformity. Vanous treatment options available till now failed to address to all these problems at once and required multiple visits to the hospital which resulted in less patient compliance. Also, the delicate nose associated bone (vomen) was prone to

fracture because of undue forces on it in the process of aligning the jaw fragments together.

ments together.

Dr Ashith is one among the 10 people who has been ualned in India by Smile Train. In India there are at least 36 lash children who are suffering from cleft lip and hence the MCODS is planning to launch a fellowship programme for students of other colleges so that more experts are available. Dr Ashith has also set up the Vimal Raj Foundation – hamed after his parents were all the prize money at various competitions is pooled in for treatment of the poor. The fee charged from well to do patients is also added to the fund. The innovation also won first prize in various competitions including one organised by Indian orthodontic Society.

He is the Vice Principal, Sudha Rustagi College of Dental Sciences, Faridabad, Head of Department, Department of Orthodontics, Sudha Rustagi College of Dental Sciences and also runs a successful private practice in Delhi.

## Good day sir, thank you for agreeing for the interview. Could you tell us a bit about yourself?

I come from a middle class family with a service background. My father, being from a transferable job, kept us as a family always on the move. I was the only one to join the dental field from a family of engineers, my father being a civil engineer and my elder brother an architect. Integration comes naturally and hard work is the hall-mark of the middle class. With limited means, we (my brother& I), always knew that education was the most that our parents could provide us with. He excelled and moved to the US in 1991 on a scholarship and I used my share of the "finances" to join CODS.....

#### How would you recall the days back at MCODS or CODS as it was then called?


