Dr TMA Pai, the founder of the Kasturba Medical College, Manipal realized this fact and taking advantage of the full-fledged Medical and Engineering Colleges already established by him, embarked on the establishment of College of Pharmacy in 1963 as part of the Kasturba Medical College. To begin with, Diploma of Pharmacy (1963) course was started followed by B Pharm (1965), M Pharm (1970), Pharm D and Pharm D Post Baccalaureate (2008).

MCOPS @ 50

Founded by Dr T M A Pai in 1963 and christened as College of Pharmacy, the institution was for more than two decades a satellite of Kasturba Medical College. After moving to the new premises in the eighties, the college got independent status and became College of Pharmaceutical Sciences (COPS) and later Manipal College of Pharmaceutical Sciences (MCOPS).

From the very beginning, MCOPS had men of repute to guide and nurture it. Earlier, the head of the institution was designated Director. Prof N K Basu, a medicinal chemist was the first Director. After his retirement, Prof N Krishnamurthy played the role of Director. Dr P Gundu Rao took up the post from Prof Krishnamurthy. When Dr Rao went on an overseas assignment, the college got a new Director in Dr S Sankarasubramanian. Dr Gundu Rao again assumed the office of Director after his return. It was during his second tenure that MCOPS became a full-fledged college and Dr Rao became the principal. Dr M N A Rao was the next to head the institution and he was in charge until 1997. From 1997 onwards Dr N Udupa was at the helm in MCOPS until his retirement in 2013.

MCOPS has a come a long way since 1963. The college has DPharm, BPharm, MPharm (11 specialisations), PharmD, PharmD Post-Baccalaureate and PhD programmes running successfully. All the programmes conducted at MCOPS have received the sanction from AICTE and/PCI. The institution, a constituent college of Manipal University, has got "A" accreditation from NAAC and certification from ISO 9001:14 000.

MCOPS has received significant financial assistance from AICTE, DST, DBT, UGC and other funding agencies helping it to modernize its laboratories and remove obsolescence. New buildings and extensions have been made to keep pace with the newer initiatives and courses that were launched in the last few years. With modern well-equipped laboratories and air-conditioned lecture halls, there is the right ambience for learning in the college. A significant number of post-graduate students are recipients of GATE or GPAT scholarship from AICTE.

MCOPS is a Quality Improvement Centre, recognised by AICTE. This has enabled teachers from other institutions to choose MCOPS for pursuing their doctoral work. Most of the faculty members at MCOPS have acquired PhD or are working for it. Up until now, MCOPS has produced 117 PhD holders, 1,552 research publications in National/International journals of repute, 1,557 conference presentations, 12 books, 8 patents. Besides, it has received more than 15 crores grant-in-aid from various funding sources. The college, therefore, is verily a research hub. Faculty, research scholars and postgraduates publish their work in reputed journals with impact factor besides making presentations at national and international conferences.

Seminars, Workshops and Symposiums held regularly, keep the college a beehive of activity all through the year. These academic exercises help to update faculty and students with the developments in pharmaceutical sciences. Learning process is thereby facilitated.

Interaction with pharma industry is kept alive through the Industry-Institute-Partnership Cell. MCOPS has a Placement Cell that facilitates campus recruitment by pharma companies. MCOPS graduates and postgraduates have found suitable placement in reputed pharmaceutical companies and academic institutions, in India and abroad.

Our alumni strength as on today is 5599. Many of whom are doing exceedingly well in careers, are our ambassadors. A few are very successful entrepreneurs with flourishing business or industries.

Indian Pharmaceutical Congress (IPC) is an annual conference of pharmacists where a large number of delegates participate. Manipal has the unique distinction of playing host to this event thrice- 23rd (1972), 42nd (1990) and 62nd (2010). The 62nd IPC in December 2010 brought close to 9000 delegates to this township. For Manipal this meet was a record in terms of number of delegates.

MCOPS celebrated its Golden Jubilee in 2012-13 through yearlong academic and non-academic programmes. Six conferences/conventions, a cricket T20 tournament, national pharmacy quiz and a number of workshops, staff development programmes and summer training school were held.

Now in the 52nd year of its existence, MCOPS is the destination for all those who aspire for quality education in pharmaceutical sciences in India. Nothing would have pleased the Founder of Manipal more!

Annual Report (January - December 2013)

1. Academic Status:

The college conducts D Pharm, B Pharm, M Pharm, Pharm D and Pharm D Post Baccalaureate and Ph D programmes. M Pharm is offered in 10 specializations based on the industry and academic needs. These specializations are Pharmaceutics, Industrial Pharmacy, Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Pharmacology, Pharmacognosy, Pharmaceutical Marketing, Pharmaceutical Administration, Pharmacy Practice, Pharmaceutical Quality Assurance, Drug Regulatory Affairs and Pharmaceutical Biotechnology. The college has been offering PhD programmes for the last three decades. Currently, PhD programmes are supported by various funding agencies such as AICTE - QIP, DST, DBT, ICMR, CSIR and DST - INSPIRE. Apart from this, Manipal University offers Structured PhD programme which enables many pharmacy post graduates to work for their doctorate degrees. The Dr TMA Pai Endowment Chair will also give an opportunity for the students to pursue their interest in PhD at MCOPS.

During the current (2013-14) academic year, 85 B Pharm, 30 Pharm D, 8 Pharm D Post Baccalaureate and 126 M Pharm candidates were admitted. The total student strength is 838, the breakup of which is as follows: B Pharm (I-IV) 387, Pharm D (I-V) 177, Pharm D Post Baccalaureate (I-III) 24, M Pharm (I, II) 250 and PhD 46.

(b) <u>Teaching</u>:

Manipal College of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Manipal has 73 experienced teaching faculty members. Most of MCOPS faculty members are doctorate degree holders and committed towards teaching and research. The passion with which they teach is reflected in the enviable success of the students in the

exa[minations. No wonder the students have rated the faculty with a high score of 4.2 on a scale of 5. Their research skills are also exemplary.

Apart from the full-time faculty, five faculty members from other sister institutions of Manipal University and 36 guest teachers from various reputed pharmaceutical industries supplement the teaching. Further, 75 supporting staff members provide technical assistance to the faculty and students.

(c) Research:

MCOPS is known for its research activity and output. The faculty, post graduates and research scholars publish their research outcome regularly in national and international journals of repute. In the current year, 114 research papers were presented in various national and international level conferences and 152 research papers were published with a total impact factor of 72.65. 
