The approval of new regulations in the biopharmaceutical industry, together with current global socioeconomics, technological innovations, and the patent expiry of biologics are the main drivers for the rise of the biosimilars market.

New regulations, healthcare expenditure cuts and advances in manufacturing techniques have determined the appearance of a new market for biosimilars, which is comparable to that of generic drugs.
