The selection will be limited to the delegates of the Annual Congress of SFE-India (SFEC 2019, Manipal) who will register for the congress and their paper should be accepted for oral presentation. Participants engaged in research in any field of Ethnopharmacology and Medicinal Plants up to the age of 40 years are eligible.

Selection of the participants for the completion will be based on the abstracts which has been submitted by young researchers and accepted for oral presentation in the annual SFE congress. Three best presentations will be awarded.

This award will be conferred on the basis of the oral presentation during the congress where the presentation will be judged by the experts from different areas, as decided by SFE-India.

This is a very beautiful island which can be reached from a place very near to Malpe beach.
