Manipal Centre for Humanities, located in the scenic campus town of Manipal in coastal Karnataka, was founded in 2010 to establish a premier institution for teaching and research in the humanities and social sciences. One of the most exciting academic experiments in higher education in India, MCH fosters a culture of innovative and reflexive pedagogy, intellectual freedom, student initiatives, and new directions in scholarship.

Overview

Manipal Centre for Humanities (MCH) is one of only two Centres of Excellence in the Manipal Academy of Higher Education (MAHE). MAHE is among the original six Institutes of Eminence declared by the Government of India in 2017. MCH is deeply committed to encouraging critical and creative thinking across a wide variety of disciplines in the fields of humanities and social sciences. It remains strongly aligned with the New Education Policy in its focus on India-relevant research and employment opportunity, as well as the United Nations mandate on Sustainable Development Goals.

Faculty at MCH are trained at some of the leading universities in India and abroad. Engaged in pioneering research that contributes to their teaching, they have published extensively, both nationally and internationally. Some of the core areas of engagement are Gender Studies, Social History, Western Philosophy, Film Studies, Political Sociology, Medical Sociology, Contemporary Literature, Modern Indian History, Visual Culture, Linguistics, Languages and Cultural Mediation. The faculty-to-student ratio has been deliberately kept low in accordance with best international practice to ensure that students get exceptional academic attention and guidance.

Students come to MCH from many of India's premier undergraduate colleges and from universities across the world. MCH Alumni have gone on to have successful careers in media, publishing, education, social sector, corporate sector, and arts management. Students have also been accepted in programs in several prestigious international universities.



The campus with its traditional central courtyard and commanding view of Manipal Lake offers excellent physical infrastructure, including library and auditorium. It regularly hosts workshops, internships, conferences, writing courses and guest lectures by renowned scholars and artists.

Life at MCH not only offers a nurturing academic environment but an opportunity to savor a taste of life by the sea. Flanked by the sylvan greens of the Western Ghats and the golden beaches of the Arabian Sea, Manipal facilitates time for personal growth, sports, and cultural events.



BA /BA (Hons) with Majors, Minors and Double Majors

BA/BA (Honours) is a carefully curated liberal arts degree that inculcates varied critical and creative skills across three years (BA) with the option of a fourth-year research track for a BA(Honours) degree.

Keeping the larger goals of multi-disciplinarity in mind, the first two semesters of the program offer a wide range of **Foundation Courses** for a strong grounding in fundamental concepts and recent scholarship.

At the end of the first year, students decide between **three learning pathways** to study Majors, Double Majors, and Minors by opting as one of the following: **Explorer** (1 Major + 1 Minor), **Innovator** (1 Major + 2 Minors) and **Consolidator** (2 Majors).

The program incorporates credited coursework in Extra Disciplinary Competencies (EDC) through six semesters to nurture valued skillsets and to support self-development.







MA in Sociology




