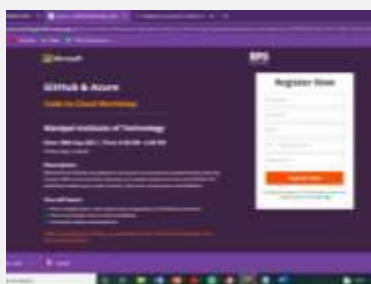

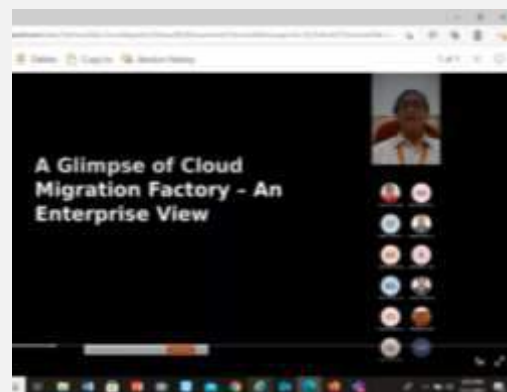


National Cyber Security Awareness Month-October 2021
