

#### Bidding adieu to Mr. Deveshwar

Mr. Yogesh Chander Deveshwar affectionately called YCD stood tall among the corporate titans. That stature was acquired through years of hard work, during which he set his sights on changing the course of ITC. Thanks to his far-sightedness coupled with brilliant managerial skills, ITC has been transformed from a "cigarette company" to a company "which also makes cigarettes". His vision extended beyond the typical return on investment, capital rationing, cash flow etc. He envisioned ITC as a company that created and nurtured sustainable livelihoods and value-chains that helped societies and enriched the environment. In his speeches, Mr. Deveshwar, frequently alluded to terms like waterpositive, carbon-positive and solid waste recycling positive. His commitment to this cause can be gauged from the fact that presently ITC is amongst few large companies that is water positive, carbon positive, and meets nearly half its energy needs from renewable sources. It is for his thrust on environment sustainability for which Mr. Deveshwar will be best remembered.


#### Bidding adieu to Mr. Deveshwar

Under his leadership, the company saw its stock prices soar 50-fold and its revenues grow 16-fold. Over the last two decades, he guided ITC to become India's leading FMCG company, the country's largest paperboards and packaging company and a corporate enabler in farmer-empowerment, through its wideranging agri-business. It also has the second largest hotel chain in India. In 2018, during the post-AGM press meet, he remarked "See, many had questioned my drive towards creating a strong FMCG portfolio (beyond cigarettes) ... today that segment is growing." At the 2018 AGM, Mr. Deveshwar had said: "Today, it gives me immense pride that your company has truly emerged as an exemplary national institution. It is indeed fulfilling to witness the enormous value that your company has created across so many dimensions. However, as I have always said, the best is yet to come. The foundations are in place."

He was conferred the Padma Bhushan for his service to the nation in 2011, while his corporate vision led the Harvard Business School to rank him among the ten best performing CEOs globally. In his homage, the ITC Managing Director Mr. Sanjiv Puri described Mr. Deveshwar's contribution as having "passionately championed the cause for sustainable and inclusive growth as well as the transformative role businesses could play in creating larger societal value." As a testament to this fact, the ITC business models today supports over 6 million livelihoods – many of them amongst the weakest section in society.


