SITE INSPECTION BY HOTEL SCHOOL OF DISTINCTION



December 05-07, 2022: WGSHA hosted a two-member team from Hotel Schools of Distinction (HSD), USA that was on a site visit to evaluate WGSHA's application for full membership to the organization. The team comprised of Dr John Niser, Director, Hospitality and Tourism Management at the International School of Hospitality, Sports, and Tourism Management of Fairleigh Dickinson University, USA and Dr. Ralf Burbach, Head of the Hospitality Management Discipline and Assistant Head of the School of Hospitality Management and Tourism, Technological University Dublin, Ireland.

The team interviewed faculty members and students, toured the college, carried-out academic audits, and inspected university facilities.

In their meeting with the Vice-Chancellor, Dr. Niser and Dr. Burbach expressed satisfaction with the college's infrastructure, pedagogy, research, and extension work. Issues related to joint research, staff and student exchange, summer school, etc. were discussed. The team members attended and participated in the Annual Day programme on the 06th of December 2022 and were impressed with the cultural show and the lavish buffet the students put together. During this event, they met Mr. Anil Chadha who is the Divisional

Chief Executive of ITC's hotel business (and a WGSHA alumnus) and conveyed their appreciation for ITC commitment to nurturing future generations of hospitality professionals with this accreditation, WGSHA will become the only hospitality institute in the Asia-Pacific region to be accredited by the Hotel Schools of Distinction (HSD), USA, and will join a select and global group of 9 hospitality management institutes in the world.

Mr. Bose was amazed by seeing the 5-star facility being experienced by the students at this institute.






BELLA ITALIA SIMULATION II






PERSONAL BRANDING BY DR. BALAJI




CHRISTMAS LUNCH HOSTEL FESTIVAL
