GA1	Intellectual rigour	Student should have clarity in thinking and an ability to think carefully, deeply and with rigour when faced with new knowledge and arguments.
GA2	Creativity	To have an ability to develop creative and effective responses to intellectual, professional and social challenges
GA3	Ethical practice	Commitment to sustainability and high ethical standards in social and professional practices
